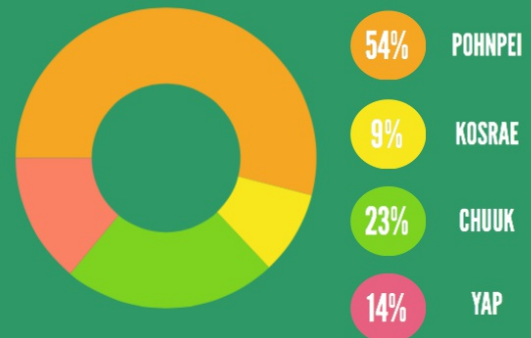


FSM TOTAL USE OF ENERGY PRODUCTS
(fossil fuel & electricity)

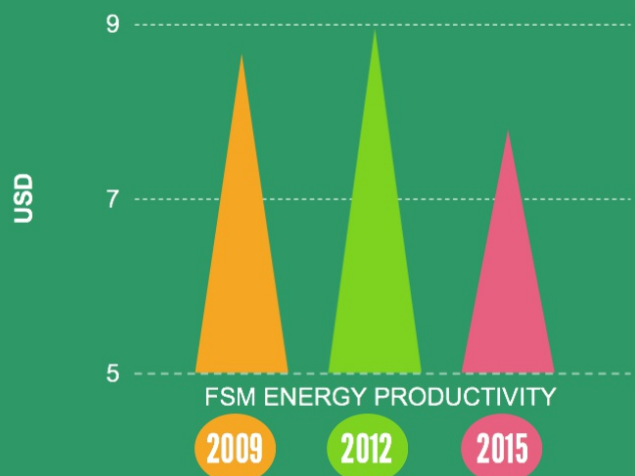


FSM LOSS IN ENERGY CONVERSION
