<p>Turn on your radio to listen to the weather broadcast.</p>	<p>Continue to monitor the weather updates.</p>	<p>Continue to monitor the weather updates.</p>
<p>Secure your home - tie down the roofs, trim trees if needed, fix leakages & close all windows.</p>	<p>Stay away from coasts and riverbanks, move to higher grounds.</p>	<p>Stay indoors until there is an "ALL CLEAR" message issued.</p>
<p>Store adequate food supply and clean water for at least 3 days.</p>	<p>Refrain from fishing and farming.</p>	<p>Leave evacuation area ONLY when declared by authorities.</p>
<p>Prepare your emergency kit - first aid kit, flash light, candles, & matches.</p>	<p>Cancel all travels and outdoor activities.</p>	<p>If your house is damaged, check if it's safe & stable for you to enter. Take photos of the damages and make sure to report it to the authorities.</p>
<p>Take note of your state hotlines in case of an emergency.</p>	<p>Stay inside safe and strong concrete houses with no windows.</p>	<p>Watch out for live wires and outlets.</p>
<p>Be on standby to assess when it may be necessary for you to evacuate for safer areas.</p>	<p>Shut off the electricity if water starts to enter the house.</p>	<p>Check water supply to make sure it's safe to drink.</p>
	<p>Wear dry and warm clothes.</p>	<p>Clear the driveway!</p>
	<p>If asked to evacuate by authorities, shut all windows, turn off main power and evacuate calmly.</p>	
	<p>STAY INDOORS!</p>
